The LC Alumni Office is excited to announce two of the 2012 Alumni Achievement Award recipients. **Mike Lumppp '62** will be presented with the **Alumni Achievement Award in Business**. Mike owned and operated M & M Vending in Lincoln and Bloomington for 37 years before retiring. He served as the President of the LC Alumni Association for several years and

is an avid Lynx basketball fan. As a resident of Lincoln, Mike devoted countless hours to community service and has financially supported many local projects.

Dr. William Rhoten '62 will be presented with the most prestigious of LC's awards, **The Distinguished Alumni Achievement Award**. Dr. Rhoten received the Alumni Achievement Award in 1972 for his achievements in the field of science. Fifty years after his graduation from Lincoln College, Dr. Rhoten has set an amazing example of the success one can achieve when one puts his mind to it. He has been involved in groundbreaking scientific research, some of which has been funded by NASA, NIH and various foundations. He has been awarded two Fulbright Senior Scholarships, one to Uganda in 1990 and a second to Zimbabwe in 1996. Dr. Rhoten has had the opportunity to be involved in many life-changing experiences abroad and in the U.S. The Alumni Office is thrilled to be able to award the second ever Distinguished Alumni Achievement Award to Dr. William Rhoten of Beaufort, S.C.
