Responsibility Statement

Once the students register, they are financially responsible for those courses and applicable charges.

Students must have all tuition and fees paid no later than the first day of the session for which they are registered, unless prior arrangements have been made. Students failing to meet this deadline will be assessed a \$75 processing fee for monthly payments.

Refund Periods for Official Withdrawal or Dismissal from LCN - 16 Week Term

- 100% - Before the term begins
- 90% - During the 1st week of the term
- 85% - During the 2nd week of the term
- 80% - During the 3rd week of the term
- 70% - During the 4th week of the term
- 65% - During the 5th week of the term
- 60% - During the 6th week of the term
- 55% - During the 7th week of the term
- 50% - During the 8th week of the term
- 40% - During the 9th week of the term
- 0% - After the 9th week of the term

Reduction in Hours Policy

Student aid eligibility is based on the number of credit hours enrolled on census day. Students who change from full to part-time status or part-time students who reduce the number of credit hours carried may receive a reduction of net tuition according to the following schedule.

1. If the reduction is on or before the census day, all net tuition not applicable to the new part-time status is reduced.
2. If the reduction is after the census day but no later than the end of the fifth week of classes, 25% of the difference in net tuition charge only is reduced.

Withdrawal Policy- 16 Week

A grade of “W” will be recorded if the student withdraws prior to the end of the guaranteed “W” date (Mar 16, 2012). After that date, a grade of “W” will be recorded if the student is earning a “C” or better.

A grade of “WF” is recorded if the student is earning a “D” or an “F”.

Financial Responsibility Statement

1. A student is officially enrolled until withdrawing with an academic advisor.
2. If a student stops attending classes, the student remains financially responsible for ALL tuition and fees unless officially withdrawing with an academic advisor.
3. If there is a balance due on the student’s account and the student does not follow proper withdrawal procedures, the entire amount of the tuition and fees will remain due.
4. All refunds due to the student will be paid in 60 days.
