

LINCOLN COLLEGE

ACCESS PROGRAM

The Academy of Collegiate Collaboration for Effective Student Success (ACCESS) program is designed to enable students with AD/HD to access and succeed at the college level.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PROGRAM

The program is housed within the Office for Disability Services and is open to students who are registered with ODS and who have a diagnosis of AD/HD.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- **ACCESS Prep program**

This is a five day intensive course held the week before classes begin. The goal of the course is to prepare students to enter into the college curriculum, which is accomplished by building a supportive community with other students, attending academic skill building classes throughout the week, getting organized for the fall semester, and meeting 1-on1 with an ACCESS coach.
- **Weekly meetings with an ACCESS Coach**

Students are assigned to an ACCESS Coach who will meet regularly with them throughout the semester. The purpose of the coaching sessions is to aid students in their transition to college, and to help students build self management skills. This is accomplished by assisting students with goal-setting, study strategy techniques, helping with time management and organizational skills, and helping students to hold themselves accountable for their learning.
- **Weekly follow-up reports to students and parents**

ACCESS coaches submit a follow up report to students at the end of the week which reminds them of their weekly goals and their progress toward semester goals. In addition, the Coach sends weekly updates to the parents to inform them of their student's progress.
- **Assistance with implementing ODS accommodations**

COST

Cost for the program is \$2,250 each semester. Students can register for ACCESS at any point during their time at Lincoln College, and the cost will be prorated for students who enter into the program after the beginning of the semester. Refunds are not available for cancellation; however, students may elect to opt out of the program at any time.

REGISTRATION

To register for the program, students must first register with ODS and also submit the ACCESS Registration form.
